



Reflections of Grace Classical Academy Parents:

1. (Q&A with Jenn, a mother of 1st and 4th grade girls)

GCA: What positive impact has being at GCA had on your child?

Jenn: My 4th grade daughter is becoming very conscious of God, obeying God and loving God. My 1st grader has a positive outlook on school, and enjoys learning and being there.

GCA: What is your child learning?
